Directions:

1. Your instructor will divide the class into groups of two.
2. Using your technical program shop or classroom as a workplace, create a health and environmental safety inspection checklist and include the following procedures and hazards:
 - Fall protection procedures
 - Ladder safety procedures
 - Stair safety procedures
 - Scaffold safety procedures
 - Struck-by hazards
 - Caught-in-between hazards
 - Construction hazards
 - Hazardous materials
 - Environmental hazards
 - Welding and cutting hazards
 - Confined space hazards
 - Fire hazards
3. Once the list has been completed, work through the inspection checklist and make observations and note the following:
 - Which of your safety guidelines are followed
 - Which of your safety guidelines need attention
4. Once all groups have completed their inspection checklist, correct all errors which need attention. This will assure a safe and healthy work area. Then, write a brief paragraph which explains the importance of hazard communication. Additionally, identify the impacts of accident costs.
