

School-Age Insight Pamphlet

Directions:

In groups, develop a pamphlet outlining the major milestones of a school-age child. The target audience of the pamphlet is families with school-age children. Additionally, the pamphlet should look like a pamphlet which could be picked up in a doctor's office.

1. Create a pamphlet with a fully designed front and back cover plus six interior pages.
2. The front cover should include a creative name for the pamphlet and a graphic.
3. The back cover should include a list of at least five sources where further information can be obtained and a graphic.
4. The five interior pages of the pamphlet should outline:
 - Milestones occurring during each year, including physical, cognitive, social and emotional developments
 - Nutritional, physical, emotional, social and intellectual needs
 - Typical growth
 - Importance of school
 - Importance of self and group identity
5. The sixth interior page should address school-age children with special needs. It should include:
 - Strategies for optimizing development
 - Differences in the needs of special needs toddlers
 - Organizations who focus on special needs, for example March of Dimes
6. Use creativity and design to make your pamphlet visually appealing.
7. Include a bibliography of the sources of the images, illustrations and information presented on a separate sheet of paper to be turned in with the pamphlet.
