Directions:

1. Your instructor will divide the class into groups of three or four.
2. Identify all personal protective equipment within the shop area. Include things such as gloves, hard hats, safety goggles, etc.
3. Once all personal protective equipment has been identified, inspect each piece of equipment for faults, such as:
 - Cracks
 - Dents
 - Rips, tears, cuts
 - Missing components
4. Decide if each piece of equipment passes or fails the inspection. Notify your instructor of any faults in the equipment.
5. Demonstrate the use and care of each piece of personal protective equipment and clean the equipment if necessary.
