

# Memorial Tribute

## *Directions:*

1. Turn on your skillet of pan melt glue or glue gun.
2. Begin with a piece of Styrofoam<sup>®</sup>. Cut the foam to fit into the plastic container. It is best to glue the foam into the container, but if the containers will be reused, do not glue the foam into the container.
3. If a pick machine is available to you, use the machine to lengthen your stems. If the machine is not available to you, proceed to the next step. Remember the picks are very sharp, so take care not to cut yourself or others with the picks. Fold the stems in half before using the pick machine to make sure the pick is firmly attached to the floral material.
4. You will be making a circular arrangement, so start with your tallest flower in the center of the foam and radiate outward with your other floral materials from that point.
5. Make sure to use plenty of glue to secure your floral materials to the foam.
6. As floral materials are added, make sure your design is attractive from all angles.
7. Once the design is finished, your instructor will test your mechanics to make sure all materials are securely attached.
