

# How to List an Industry Certification on Your LinkedIn Profile



LinkedIn is a powerful tool social media platform that connects like-minded professionals and helps individuals expand their networks. A well-maintained profile on LinkedIn strengthens users' experiences and makes them easily identifiable to employers and other interested parties.

LinkedIn allows users to build a comprehensive profile that is not limited by space like traditional resumes. Just like it's important to list an industry certification on a resume, individuals should include their industry certifications on their LinkedIn profiles.

To list an industry certification to your LinkedIn profile, complete the following steps:

## NAME OF INDUSTRY CERTIFICATION

- If not already included, add the Licenses & Certifications section to your profile
- Click the + sign in the Licenses & Certifications section. A pop-up window will appear on your screen

## NAME OF ORGANIZATION

- Enter the complete certification name  
Example: Southwest Airlines Professional Communications Certification
- Enter the Issuing Organization  
Example: Southwest Airlines

## ISSUE DATE & EXPIRATION DATE

- Remember to click the checkbox that says, "This credential does not expire" if the certification does not have an expiration date
- Enter the date of issuance  
Example: October 2020

## CREDENTIAL ID & URL

- Enter the Credential ID  
Use the Certification ID listed on the paper certificate you received after earning the industry certification
- You can also add a Credential URL to help others learn more about the industry certification.

# How to Add Skills to Your LinkedIn Profile

Along with including an industry certification on a user's LinkedIn profile, listing specific skills on LinkedIn allows users to showcase their abilities. Certification earners can list the industry standards assessed in the certification exam as skills on their LinkedIn profile.

After a user has listed a skill on their profile, 1st degree connections will have the opportunity to validate these skills. An endorsement provides further credibility to the user's LinkedIn profile and increases the likelihood of being discovered in searches related to that particular skill.

To list a skill on your LinkedIn profile, complete the following steps:

## NAME OF INDUSTRY CERTIFICATION

- If not already included, add the Skills & endorsements section to your profile
- Click Add a new skill in the Skills & endorsements section. A pop-up window will appear on your screen
- Enter the skill  
Example: Interpersonal Communications
